



## Popular Sightseeing Options

### 1. Rheinfall

Most powerful waterfall in Europe, 150 metres (490 ft) wide and 23 metres (75 ft) high.

### 2. Mount Pilatus

Reach the top at 1915m (6'289ft) with the Pilatus Railway, the world's steepest cogwheel railway and enjoy fabulous views over Switzerland (costs CHF 78.-/person).

### 3. Lucerne

Picturesque city, nestled between lake and mountains, has a lot to offer historically, culturally and socially. Experience the unique landscape with the vibrant city and the calmness of Lake Lucerne.

### 4. Monastery St. Urban

Former Cistercian monastery founded in 1194, Swiss heritage site of national significance.

### 5. Meilenstein Langenthal Formula 1 Museum & Aquarium

Museum with two- and four-wheeled vehicles such as oldtimers, Formula 1 cars (also world championship vehicles) or other rarities and a 137ft aquarium inhabited by sturgeon, catfish, rays and many others.

### 6. Feldschlösschen Brewery

Largest beer brewery in Switzerland, founded in 1876.

### 7. Cheese Factory Emmental

Scenic drive to the Emmental Show Dairy. Learn interesting facts about the history of the world famous *Emmentaler* cheese and how it is made. Watch and lend a hand as fresh cheese is made daily (Summertime only). Taste some cheese and visit the specialty cheese shop. Highly recommended!!
